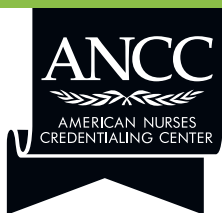

What Does My Hospital Have to Provide?

Co-host hospitals are asked to have a minimum of 28 participants. The participants may be from the co-host facility or those that sign up based on advertising from the ANCC website.

Several hospitals can co-host together reducing the minimum number for each hospital.

ANCC will provide on-line registration services, continuing nursing education contact hours, and a notebook of presentation slides provided for each participant. We will also provide your hospital with speakers whose schedule and fees, including hotel and travel, will be managed by ANCC.

CNEs and Scheduling

All seminars include continuing nursing education (CNE) contact hours.

Seminars are normally scheduled from 8:00 am until 4:30 pm daily but can be scheduled to begin earlier or later, if necessary.
