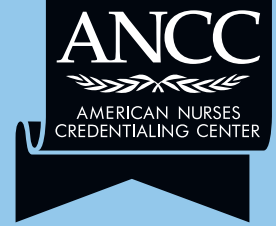


Abstract Submission Form

Researchers investigating the relationship between characteristics of the professional nursing practice environment and nursing, organizational, or patient outcomes are invited to submit abstracts. Affiliation with a Magnet® organization is not required. Abstracts are sought from researchers in multiple disciplines in academic or healthcare settings.

- > Abstracts must be based on completed, data-based research. Results must be described in abstract submission.
- > Abstracts will undergo blind peer review.
- > Selection criteria include quality of the research, potential significance, relevance to the purpose of the symposium, and clarity of the abstract.
- > Full papers and slides for accepted presentations will be due two weeks in advance of the symposium date for review by session discussants.
- > Selected presenters must register for the symposium and assume costs related to travel, accommodations, and registration.

Abstract Submission Instructions:

- > The primary author must complete the abstract submission form. ANCC will correspond with only one author.
- > Abstracts must be received between Monday, February 15 and Monday, April 5, 2010. Applications arriving after the deadline will not be accepted.
