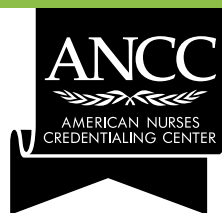

What Does My Hospital Have to Provide?

Co-host hospitals are asked to have a minimum of 28 participants. The participants may be from the co-host facility or those that sign up based on advertising on the ANCC website.

Several hospitals can co-host together—reducing the minimum number for each hospital. Co-host hospitals also provide a room for the seminar, audio-visual equipment, and beverages.

What Does ANCC Provide?

ANCC provides online registration services, continuing nursing education contact hours, and a national expert speaker, including all fees, travel, hotel, and per diem. We also provide a notebook of presentation slides for each participant.

CNEs and Scheduling

All seminars include continuing nursing education (CNE) contact hours.

Seminars are normally scheduled from 8:00 am until 4:30 pm daily but can be scheduled to begin earlier or later, if necessary.
